

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
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REALITY

Ever woke up in the morning, had a flash at the news and felt really wrong about how the world is working right now? It's scary to see how everyone is involved in conflict and killing each other out in the sake of natural resources, ideologies, money and power.

Everyone has the right to feel sad for the rest of the world while keeping uninvolved and just expecting for the right persons to address each problem. In a pessimistic point of view, nothing can be done about it – even science calls out the entropy factor, the natural decay of material fabric, including energy itself – but, is it really that we are actually watching the end of days? The battle between good and evil?

There is a war being fought right now, out there, one that has lasted since humans learned how to control other humans by the means of power given by control of the fire, or just as simply as grabbing a rock and learning how to throw it to an opponent's head.

There are two points of view as to whether the human is corrupt by nature, or not. Idealists tend to think that the human is pure by nature, as was created to God's image and perfection. Under this perspective, babies are the perfect beings, full of light and so empty of viciousness and wrong intentions.

It's easy to understand the other point of view, like the one offered by the Mayans book Popol Vuh, in which a battered down Quetzalcoatl comes back from death and feels baffled at the fact that the human bones he just recovered were now incomplete and bit by animals; his companion, a dog advices him the finished what he started, thus offering a rather metaphorical explanation of how corrupt the human is by nature.

Actually, things are rather much simpler. It's a matter of math. But wait! What does mathematics have to do with spirituality at all? Everything. Science has led us to think that math are just an abstract representation of reality, but in fact it is the other way round: reality is an abstraction of ontological mathematics, the numbers of becoming.

In most traditional spiritual schools and doctrines, people are taught that there are three main realms: the material in which you are living right now, a worst one, full of pain – such as hell, and a better one, heaven, in which everyone is happy. You are always given a choice for you to take.

This is basically a metaphor used to condition your behavior, to be able to distinguish those who are good from evil. There are this better or worse spiritual places to which you can go conditioned by your behavior.

This concept mostly applies to religions, that conditions subjects rewards after a life full of actions. Under these doctrines, you have to wait to die to even get a glimpse at these 'spiritual' domains, so, whether human is corrupted by nature or not, he has to abide a set of rules in order to achieve the next level in spirituality.

What most religions wont ever teach you about it, mathematics is actually what is used to actually create the universe itself. If you are able to understand the nature of ontological math, then you are well on your way up to a higher spiritual understanding.

Visualize it by clearing up the universe to a whole pitch black void. Turn around to your right, and you will see the number one, a bright spark that represents The Monad, a number that represents unity and reason. If you cloned that monad and placed it somewhat to the right of the original one, you could well draw a line between those two.

If you cloned a third monad, you would get a triangle, which now can contain things, you could fill it up. Add a fourth one and you would get a square, a plane. If you kept adding four more, you could actually create a cube, a three dimensional shape.

Think of the Cosmos as a set of ever reproducing monads that form the complex geometry of the actual fabric of the universe, which is not just a bunch of galaxies, nebulae and black holes, indeed you could think of space a humongous representation of what is happening down below at monadic level and everything in between.

Everything happens at different levels, and that is how one achieves TRUE spirituality, understanding how mathematics ARE the Cosmos, and such, scientific mathematics can be used to understand some of the aspects of reality itself, specially with quantum physics.

ABOUT YOUR DESTINY

There's an interesting point of convergence in both science and religions. They all stand for the argument that God has a destiny for each and everyone of us. Curiously enough, most new-age beliefs and subjects are about writing your own destiny.

How can this be possible? Is it that God really has a plan for each person and living being in the earth and beyond? How can there be free will, then, if he so has pointed out that he has this perfect plan? Religion purists may argue that free will exists and it is respected even by God, but if so, then how would God's plan be carried out if the player isn't playing anymore?

In case someone decided not to play God's plan, was that written out by himself or by God? Is that really taking a choice or carrying out God's own choice? In the bible, you can find plenty of situations in which God asked someone to do something, and he just went out and did, even if they were torturous, like in Job's example.

Now, while science doesn't talk about a plan for everyone in the universe, it has created a set of rules through which the universe is understood. One of this particular rules talks about causality, cause and effect. The group of visible and invisible factors that lead to a result.

Known as 'The chaos theory', this set of rules determine how some rather zanny effects may produce a whole range of effects on other places and/or times. The typical 'butterfly effect', in which it's explained how can a butterfly flapping its wings in China may produce a tornado in America. This would explain how 'random' doesn't really exist.

What science offers is a deterministic point of view, and with that pretension the scientists are somewhat able to predict nature's behavior, the only difference between science and religion points of view is actually 'free will'.

No matter what, according to religious perspective, you are falling under God's plan, if we compared that to science, maybe we could understand this plan as the rules of the physical universe. If so, we are living under a decaying God, but that couldn't be positive, would it?

If we take God as The Cosmos, we don't actually think it will die. We understand it as a set of mathematical rules, and math, as such, can't just die. Mathematics are not just about geometry, but you can use it to describe objects in the physical universe. Math are not just about formulas, but Euler's equation and Fourier transforms are living concepts that can even explain spirituality and the mind operation itself.

Free will is the difference in here, religious stance says God has already written this for you, and science says you are prey of tons of external factors and you will become one for everyone else with every move you make.

Science has tried to explain something akin to God's plan by determining the existence of multiverses, parallel universes that hold the results to whatever decisions we make. If this is right, then we would actually be living all of our consequences inside our own being, but perception holds us from acknowledging the fact that we are, in fact, a light of existence in the Cosmos that is held to it's own destiny, the one wrote by his own actions.

Ever had a dream that offered an alternate result of what you got on real life? Ever had this weird intuition that warns you of something that turned out to be true? While our sensorial input frequencies wont allow us just to simply live all of our experiences at the same time, it may allow us to appreciate the 'what if's and make better decisions, or simply live the results for awhile.

This is not divination, this is not witchcraft, this wizardry is all about giving out your best to the universe, writing a history of your own that leads you real knowledge, to enlightenment, to really understanding God and not just becoming part of it, but becoming one yourself.

Think of your soul, your monad, it has it's own place in the universe, which could be explained by a cartesian chart with six axis (three real and three imaginary). If somehow you managed to move your monad elsewhere and amplify your frequencies so you can appreciate more of reality, then you would be one step forward to becoming a HyperHuman.

So, how does one accomplish that? First of all, there's study, the only real way to achieve gnosis, knowledge, the information laid out in the universe in quantum states. Whenever you have studied enough, you may be able to appreciate the meaning behind this whole bunch of useless data. You give meaning to it, thus turning it into information.

Whatever you feed your brain is what you will get out of it. Do you want to write your own destiny by feeding it TV or do you want to fill it with gnosis that can lead you to a higher state of being?

No matter what, never leave your destiny to someone else. You are not any Jack Bauer or Beyonce, you are way better than that, and your potential is so much wider and higher. If you think your life is boring now, it may be because you are letting someone else write your destiny for you.

TRUTH VS. REALITY

People usually think of 'reality' as the material world they have in front of them, the things they can touch, smell, see and more. If it isn't there, it simply doesn't exist and that's pretty much it. Science works around this principle, they promote an hypothesis which they study and try to prove; if they do that, then they call it a theory.

Science has done a great effort into explaining lots of phenomena in the world, but one of the things that science hasn't been able to prove is the existence of God. So, how does that fit with spiritual oriented persons who believe in a force greater than their own, individual existence?

Unfortunately, it doesn't fit right, but that doesn't stop people from believing in something with all their demise and move on to a spiritual pursuit that usually starts (and ends, in many cases) in a local church. These persons assist to these temples in order to find themselves and this higher energy. For others, it's simply a matter of meditation, or follow Buda, or believing in themselves, whatever.

Just this situation alone separates the whole world into two different groups: atheists and believers. Even Richard Dawkins – the world's most famous atheist – has graciously provided us with in-between categories, such as weak believer and weak atheist.

At the end of the day, materialists, the persons who solely believe in science and hardly nothing more, tend to rationalize everything into hard science facts. On the other side we have the idealists, persons who desire to find a higher sense of self in a world beyond material, beyond their reality, in a realm that they cannot touch, see or smell, but they literally get to live inside it.

Now let's think about the old orthodox Catholic lady who depends on God for her wellbeing, to her God is absolutely real, and if it wasn't for him, she would probably have no hope or even no reason to keep alive and so well behaved. That behavior would probably be idiotic to a scientist who studies enzymes on seashells at a molecular level. For both, reality is totally different.

Ultrasonic sea life studies versus persons reading a bible. 'Reality' is being discovered by the first while the 'truth' is being discovered by the second one. The scientist is supposed to find reality, to discover what is happening behind the stage, while the second supposedly holds the 'truth', a concept, an ideal, a blueprint for the universe and even maybe a whole lifestyle, like the old church lady.

Stop for a moment and think about how similar these two words are: 'reality' and 'truth', but they stand completely opposite roots. These are words that are used often by just about anyone, but could we possibly think that because something is true, it is real? Wait, stop and really analyze the question we have just made. Could we possibly think that because something is true, it is real?

Think of aliens for a moment, many people think they exist, so it must be true, but are they real? As you can see, those are two often confused but rather different concepts. The difference between the two is that one holds FACTS, while the other holds BELIEFS. Even while people won't believe in them, they simply are out there, millions of lifeforms scattered around the universe, maybe much more primitive or advanced than us, but it would be ridiculous to affirm that we are the only living beings out here.

Reality holds facts, things that happen whether we believe in them or not. Imagine the first primitive men who sought relentlessly after the sun every day thinking of it as a light and heat giving deity who escaped during every sunset, thus bringing darkness and fear. For them, it was just a matter of survival, their truth is that the object provided them heat, for us, the sun is a giant ball of burning gas, as it has always been.

If you think about it, the primitive caveman adored the sun for the same reasons we do, even further, reality is that the sun has always been a huge burning ball of gas, independently of the beliefs we've all had. Now, extend it to whatever discovery the civilization has made from the ancient primitive caveman to the current, modern one we have now. Every discovery has just led us from truth to fact, in some cases people have been jailed for this, like Galileo Galilei.

So, the actual issue around here is how reality just is, while truth depends on perception. Think of a car accident where you are standing about 30 meters from the crash while your friend is standing on the other side of the street waiting to cross and meet you for coffee at about, let's say, 20 meters. Imagine that two cars swerve to the center of the road and crash. Depending on the position, point of view and time of focus on the accident, the conditions may look different to each spectator. For you, the guilty driver may be one while for your friend it may be other.

That's a simple example of how the theory of relativity works and the relation it holds with a fourth dimensional space, but for the sake of simplicity let's just call it as the famous and mysterious fifth dimension, which is basically the one created by relating time to space. Everything depends on the point of observation, the location.

Depending on your point of view, truths may be different to each spectator, but the reality is just one, the one that can be explained by facts. In our imaginary case the driver from the left was far more aggressive and stepped on it towards the other car, maybe a far bit too much. It wouldn't matter if you drink coffee with your friend for three hours while discussing points of view – each one will try to hold on to their own truth because they depend on their eyes to interpret what happens around them.

Reality is made of facts, while a truth depends on human perception or belief.

This leads us to think that there is so much around the world that we cannot see, or even understand, but for now let's stick to the senses: smell, touch, taste, see, hear. Do you think that not everything that you can see exists? Well, how about 3G, WiFi, bluetooth or satellite TV waves? You can't see them, but they do exist, and even though it is now rather popular technology, it could be a mystery for others who don't it, like a group of terrorized Amish.

The same happens with lots of energies that we still don't understand, or at least not on a popular level. These energies have – physically – a frequency and intensity as such, some of those energies are simply out of our perception ranges. Could you imagine a world where a bluetooth device caused you pain while using it?

The reality is that those waves are there, if you took a device to an Amish farm where no one knew the technology, they would probably couldn't even imagine that there are indeed waves invisibly floating around them, inside them, crossing their bodies. The same happens for TV, radio and even electromagnetic fields caused by EVERY gadget that uses electricity, even your own body cause different fields.

Reality is held to mathematical laws that may be out of comprehension for many, but are definitely there even if we understand them or not. That IS reality, and reality is usually beyond our perception – which we are used to mostly depend on – and that is solely individual.

Perception can be different depending on many factors such as sensory quality (like how well can you see or hear), visibility (obstacles and such), location (how near or far you are) and even reaction time (to remember our car accident example), among many others. Even your personal story, context, culture, beliefs and even mind frequencies among other factors influence your perception heavily.

TRUTH VS. REALITY

Truth is directly taken from perception, like so much people hold that their lord is their TRUE God. As such, truth also stands a position or a statement. Truth is individual, reality is collective. Truth is what you decide to believe on, but truth won't change reality, because this one is made of facts.

Now remember, even if you can't appreciate it at it's own glory, reality is far more than what your perception holds as truth. You know you are well on your way, but if somehow it has taken too long, it may not be the right path for you to take.

Many people tend to look into deities as answers for their questions, as saviors for their souls, and for many people that is the truth, but reality is you can become a god yourself, yes, a god, you. If you perfection your being every day and cultivate knowledge, refine yourself, you can become a HyperHuman, literally, a god.

REALMS OF REALITY

How would you explain spirituality to yourself? What would you think spirituality is? The fact that the world is split into two schools of thought about this concept makes hard for it to stand for Peace and Enlightenment as one. This old division between believers and non-believers have led to people dying because others could simply not stand a reality.

Think of the persons who thought that the earth was actually square and held on cosmic animals' backs. To them, finding out that the world was actually round was a sudden shock. They had their beliefs broken by a scientist. Examples like this are what makes some persons want to kill each other out, and this keeps happening now when thousands of people burn books, screaming with hatred and wanting to impose their truth in a very irrational way.

Let's face it, there are two groups of believers: those who never question what they believe in, and those who question it and want to question it more because they believe in a higher truth. The first group tends to be a religious one, the type that needs a church and thinks of an ever watching god above him; the second group tends to be spiritual persons, who have freed from religions and are on their paths to knowledge right now.

Probably you are on the second group, and be advised that freeing yourself from religion is indeed the first step in order to reach Enlightenment, which can be perfectly reached while you are alive, and not having to wait until you are dead just to see if you got there or not. Heaven or hell is a decision you can make on earth, one of the lowest frequency vibration places in the Cosmos.

The first group sometimes tends to be irrational, so when someone shares them different knowledge than the one they already have, they can become angry and can even maim people; they are not willing to see, they do not or cannot achieve Enlightenment that way, because they use anger as a method, violence as an action, thus making it impossible for them to acquire 'elevated' knowledge. They are as happy as they are now, just living on their beliefs, and that's fine the way they are now.

To reach Enlightenment you have to be free, and in order to achieve freedom you need to attain knowledge, so you can stop blaming deities for the outcome of your life, and simply become responsible for it. Be real, you need to BE responsible for yourself, if you are a ratiom, civilized person, you will find it easy to do so without causing harm to others, because you have reached a balance.

This is what conforms the second group and actually defines how far your actions set you apart from the first one. There is much knowledge to be learned and studied, it takes time and effort, but there is no point to it if you belong to the first group and don't want to set a quest towards Divinity, as it happens with the second group. Are you lazy or are you a quest seeker who wants to evolve into something more than just another human being?

Assuming you are part of the second group, the key to Enlightenment is understanding that reality is not just what you see. It is what you see and more, much more, your own mind holds the key, and perception plays a fundamental role in here.

Let's talk about the five senses, sight, hearing, taste, touch, smell. All involve a part of the body, but curiously enough no one teaches any sense that relates to the human brain, even when we know by fact that the mind plays an essential role for the human experience, and it's on your brain. So, why cant we think of any other sense that relates to the brain?

Pythagoras himself taught two more senses to his students in Croton, intuition and telepathy. With these two new additions to our brain, they could enhance their human being 'containers' into what we could consider as HyperHumans. Most people nowadays simply would discard the fact that persons could have these abilities, or at least, make them useful, and that's why most people now couldn't even try to think of Enlightenment as something real, that happens when you get enough knowledge.

These HyperHumans discretely exist until this day, simply known as Pythagoras' Mystery School, or The Illuminati. Taken wrong by society because this knowledge actually breaks down their reality, and when that is all you have, then you simply have no life left, thus leading you to hate.

Reality, as said before, depends on your perception, thus it can be as wide or narrow as you are, spiritually talking. The more you learn knowledge, the more your perception opens up, thus empowered to simply see things others cant. The secret here is your mind. The mind is everything, because it exists on a point of space and time through the form of your brain, and as energy on the 'other' realm, the realm of the mind. Actually your mind is pure energy.

This is what the great mathematician and philosopher Renatus Cartesius, father of modern philosophy, and philosopher Immanuel Kant, one of the most influent thinkers of history, held points about when talking about the world being a mental reality or a material reality.

Remember The Matrix movie? Ever read about the Holographic Spectrum? Scientists are trying to proof that there is a reality beyond our eyes, and they are turning to the brain for solutions. Even many artists are working around around brainwaves. Why is that so?

Think of material reality as a big hollow sphere placed all around you, and your eyes are actually projectors at the same time, so everywhere you turned you got to see what is actually being projected inside your brain. You have a place in Cosmos, indeed, subject mostly to the laws of physics because you are living under its laws, but you are creating your own world, literally, creating your own movie and projecting it all around.

We could think of this subjective reality such as time and space, and what you see depends on your location of these two planes, and whatever happens out of these is inside the mental domain as such. But life isn't just about these two states proposed by Descartes and Kant, it actually holds a more profound nature based on mathematics.

Yes, you've read right, the nature of reality is mathematical. Even though we could describe reality and its levels using many different points of view, the fact is that only mathematically could we prove any phenomena in the Cosmos. This doesn't mean you need to dominate math in order to enlighten yourself, it just means that the universe itself is a mathematical phenomena.

Of course, you couldn't explain all the phenomena in the universe using simple algebra or geometry. There is ontological mathematics, the math of the universe, the Platonist mathematics. Only this special type of math can join science and spirituality into a single area of study, thus allowing both to grow together and bond to reach Enlightenment.

Anyone who understands the Platonic ontological mathematical principles could well understand the Cosmos itself, and that is part of the path towards becoming a HyperHuman yourself. Even while science itself was responsible for paying few attention to Descartes and Kant's theories about the mind realm, it's science itself which is now proving them right, such as happens with quantum mechanics.

Quantum mechanics are teaching us a bunch of things, which are very useful when explaining spiritual phenomena and it's the same knowledge they are using to build a new type of computers. These quantum computers are based on the fact that a particle can not just only be on or off, but it can also be on and off, and also off and on.

Kind of complicated, and no need for further explanations right now. The point is that scientists have discovered that actual observation of the particle may change it's state and actually be what we could call multidimensional.

These quantum particles are teaching us more about the fabric of the universe than science ever could, and even so, it's still far, but well pointed to the direction of the work of this two great philosophers, who gave so much information in order to explain the phenomenons of the mind, actually lived by the Enlightened persons each and every day. Gnosis is the way.

LANGUAGE OF REALITY

Reality as such has probably been questioned since human origins, and it has never been as questioned as now. Though there are many more advancements now than ever, concepts of reality emerge everywhere around science now with the use of quantum mechanics and neurology. Science has never been closer to the spirit, but there is still a huge gap to be closed.

We'll stick to refer to reality as the set of facts, the things that happen whether we can appreciate or not. Let's call them *laws*. These laws never disappear, and even when all the universe is due to decay (from a materialistic point of view), the laws will ever be there to make sure the Cosmos works perfectly.

These laws or not unchangeable, that's the secret behind that. These laws, while being part of the Cosmos and thus giving it form, evolve along with it. The universe is a big, ever evolving behemoth that which we hold part of.

We are talking about the universe both physical, and for the sake of this document, mental or spiritual. Ontological mathematics teach us how to understand both dimensions and even navigate in them, and we know that our own mind is behind the perception of material experiences and spiritual experiences.

Your own mind holds the key, so all you need to open the door is to learn how to use it, and which way to turn, so you won't break it.

First of all, you need to learn about the language of reality. Ever heard the expression 'reality is what you make out of it'? This old saying holds a lot of truth in the aspect of the creation of your own life experience. What you are living right now is what you are writing for yourself.

You have the potential of a creator, and you are one indeed. Every second you spend living the material world is a second well spent creating the world around you. Everything you see, hear, smell, taste or feel is being created by you and yourself only.

Well, not everything, because there are many other energies around you (such as other humans or living beings) that emit their own energy both physically and mentally, but the way you perceive them varies from being to being.

This literally means that you could well be in the same room as your friend, and even though both refer to objects such as 'the blue table' or 'the big sofa', each one has his own set for dealing with reality. Let's break down thing a little.

Imagine a room with a table, a couple of sofas, a cat, two friends, having a great conversation over a nice cup of warm coffee on a table and a door. Now, imagine the energy that lies behind each living and not living object on the room, and analyze them just as entities.

The room represents a 3D space that will provide an area in which events can happen over the invisible entity called 'time'. The door would provide a way to translate from this space to another one without breaking the laws of physics, and also provide protection from any external agents.

Each entity in the room could be divided into two categories: living, or not living. Even though coffee holds energy (even warmth is considered energy, along with the sugar that could be turned into calories, and more) it is not a living, breathing, sentient, conscious being. The cat, on the other hand, is a creature, thus considered into the living category.

Each one holds back a certain type of energy. This energy defines the entity role, and could actually remind of those 90s quantum psychology subjects that proposed every object having a consciousness. Also, these energy can be harnessed, such as the first computer clock components that actually held a rock, a quartz rock, inside them to create oscillations needed for the computer to run.

Every entity in the area holds a purpose (providing a resting area - sofa), a series of properties (hot, sweet – coffee), methods (claw and attack – cat) and events (respond to cat attack – human). These are the laws that rule over every entity there. Some rules can be changed, like teaching the cat not to attack, thus providing a new, evolved rule.

Now, let's step up a little in the dimensions, using the laws and rules created in the previous layer, we can now materialize those objects into physical reality. The table becomes real, every person gives form to the energy that holds behind them under their own context and perception.

Let's realize that people do not appreciate the same colors the same way. If you say 'red', your friend will know what color you are talking about because he also associates that one with the same word: 'red'. That's a cultural agreement, but, does everyone sees the colors the same way than others? Even scientists have proved that everyone sees colors differently.

Now, we have these entities as energy generators or containers around us, and the way we appreciate them depends on what we have fed our brains with. This could amplify your language of reality.

Ever heard of demon or ghosts stories? Maybe you have lived them, watching an angel, observing a floating lady to a cemetery or even listening your name whispered in a dark corner of a lonely room. Are these really demonic processes?

Heard any stories on fairies, vampires, ghosts or even aliens? While these energies do exist, we give them form in the material world with what language we have acquired for the brain. For those persons who have lived under a bible, for example, any energy could be an angel or a demon, but for a scientist it could be a set of quantum particles playing with someone's mind, or for a psychiatrist, it could be schizophrenia.

Language plays a fundamental role on the perception of your existence. If you only feed your mind with angels and demons, those are the only ones you'll get, you'll begin to appreciate any energy as any of those two options, so your life becomes angelic or demonic.

About aliens, those definitely exist, but why do people perceive them in similar shapes? Because that's what you fed your brains with it. The more gray aliens you've seen on media, the more gray aliens you will find on the street.

How many schizophrenic persons were burnt because they were possessed? How many Parkinson disease victims had their hands cut because those were possessed? That is a very limited language.

Why do some people are prone to watching ghosts while so many don't? Because it has to deal with the language fed to deal with this issues. While an ignorant person could be afraid of a ghost, an enlightened one would only appreciate the energy behind phenomena, understand it as ontological math and not be affected by any negative energy because he's on his center.

Reality can't just be created by using Mythos (fairy tales) created by Hollywood, TV, advertising and even religion. A truly spiritual person would be able to handle his ego and start looking for reality behind it.

LANGUAGE OF REALITY

How can he do that? Easily, by acquiring knowledge, by trusting the facts given by ancient schools that not only have survived nowadays, but have refined that knowledges through ages with the use of dialectics.

The more you study and learn, the less scary your nightmares will be. You will stop thinking of yourself as a victim and more as a warrior, and scary monsters will turn into mathematical functions waiting to be solved by you.

People who are prone to watching horror movies, usually end up having a scare or two with the same type of creatures they saw there. An imaginative child may also give way to his own creations by shaping them with his mind. If this kid learned about other stuff than horror, his appreciation of life would be different and instead of thinking about demonic possessions or ghosts and ghouls, he would understand and cope with that energy in a different way.

Everything is under control for an enlightened being. If you seek spiritual knowledge far from someone else's truth and closer to reality, your best bet is to study hard and understand how the Cosmos actually works. It's not just a matter of pretending to be spiritual if you don't understand how things work. Instead of becoming a hero, you'll become just another boring number, and we know you are special, aren't you?

Add language, make your life beautiful, build a reality accord to the god you want to become, aspire to more and never stop at profundity, as there is much deeper things that need to be recovered in someone's valued mind in order to exist.

The more language you can handle, the less horrific your life with be, thus making it easier to find harmony and equilibrium.

DOMAINS OF REALITY

But just what is reality, anyways? We stated that reality stands to the facts, whether we understand them or not, so we cannot just say that reality is just what we see, as we are rather blind as bats when talking about perceiving the universe with only your sensory inputs.

Reality can't be just seen, damn, it can't even be proved by scientists or religious people... why? Because most of these groups are looking for a radical one-ended solution that will satisfy scientists or religious people, but not both.

People naturally tend to rely on someone else's knowledge to acknowledge reality, such as when you visit the doctor expecting him to tell you exactly what you have and how to cure it. You already knew you were sick, after all you were visiting the doctor, but you are seeking more profound knowledge on what you've got.

People dig knowledge, persons digs knowledge. There's this analogy of the nerdish computer technician who gets popular when someone needs fixing his PC. People need knowledge to fulfill their desire to feel comfort and tranquility. The first caveman saw the sun as their best comfort, without them knowing that the sun is a humongous burning gas ball floating in space using gravity as a motor for our planet.

When some cavemen learned how to start fire, the need for the sun diminished, and thus augmented the need for THIS particular caveman, who knew how to create it from a couple of materials. Knowledge became essential for humanity to survive. The knowledge to hunt, prepare food, bury the dead, etc.

Very few people understand that Knowledge is the key. We have talked about the language of reality, but, there's also a need on how to use it to formulate the greatest quotes people will ever read, the ones you write for yourself in your own personal history through reality.

Reality isn't just about touching. Quantum science has proved us that there are many states of the particles that make up this world, and also has proved that there are other dimensions after all (10, 11 or 13, propose the latest theories), so many of Pythagoras and Plato's theories come true with the aide of science, at least for the materialist skeptics that need to read it under a scientific journal. For spiritual people, it's a hope to be understood by science.

Every person lives all kinds of supernatural things at least once in their lifetime, they see angels saving their lives, or even God himself coming down from heaven to save a family from a flood; lesser things, like ghosts or whispers. There are many theories according to how an authentic spiritual manifestation is actually developed, and thus the search for the Higgs bosson begun.

Desperate efforts from science has been made for ways to measure 'spiritual' energy and then try to proof it's existence, but it has been futile. Zenner cards, EEG readings while some is one meditation... al have lead to significant but useless results. Why?

Every scientist takes only material realm into account. Life and reality go much more far from that, and that's the whole point. Once scientists are able to discover how to navigate through any of the 13 or so dimensions, the point will be cleared and material people will have to adapt to such new knowledge.

Meanwhile, there are many ripes in reality that may appear as 'paranormal' or 'spectral'. While most hauntings can be disproved by simple physics (by hitting a water pipe a certain time will make an echo on the house at the end of the street or so), there are many phenomena that just couldn't be explained.

Many contemporary scientific-philosophers talked about the psych-ion, a quantum particle that would explain phenomena in the universe, but a few years passed before Higgs' boson was introduced and thus the quest for the psych-ion stopped.

Certainly many people have lived some extranormal experience, something that could go to premonition, a whisper, a shadow, maybe even an object moving by itself. Most of these guys will get a big laugh on their face, because science can't explain those things (yet).

Science or not, things do happen all the time. Think of a WiFi connection, or an FM radio station or a couple of CB radios, how about 3G or even microwaves? You can't see any, but all of those are happening right now and many go where you are sitting or standing.

What science hasn't made possible yet is the human translation through all of these dimensions. Only the first three ones and puny reported attempts at tinkering with the 4th one: time. What science is missing out, and finally finding with the use of neurology, is that mind is everything. The pineal gland is the only vehicle needed to transfer your soul through any of the layers that make up existence.

Idealists tend to the idea of thinking of two worlds, the spiritual and the material one, but the fact is that reality is made out of several domains that need to be taken into account in order to ascend into a higher state of being. Let's talk about them in order.

Material domain

This is the common place common people commonly spend their time in. Their appreciation is through their senses and require time as a unit to measure their pass through the universe. This comprises anything that can be touched, felt, smelt, etc.

Energy domain

This one is based on energy fields, and even deeper, quantum. Churches usually skip this step and that's exactly what they use their rituals for. Everything has energy and thus everything vibrates. We can't take this into the Material domain, because it lives on its own rules and a domain of its own. Energy may be invisible, such as is with WiFi, 3G and Bluetooth frequencies, and even electromagnetic fields. They ARE energy, but they may disrupt both physical and spiritual domains.

Spiritual domain

This domain is not about spooky hunts or ghouls and ghosts, it makes recognizing yourself before the universe, just as you are, accept yourself with all your flaws and virtues and go beyond good and evil. You need to embrace every part of your own being in order to truly reach this level. Attending mass each Sunday won't simply work, this is an internal job you need to do with and for yourself.

Multidimensional domain

After recognizing yourself, it is necessary to let others recognize you, as well as recognizing others. In this multidimensional layer, you transcend time, matter, energy, spirit and could be in your purest form. It's as close as Abraxas as you will ever be. Hidden geometry appears out of nowhere and gives sense to your perception of reality. You may recognize yourself as 'one' with others.

Abraxas / Above / Etc.

There's more, remember that the quest here is to find your own divinity and, literally, become a god, so first take domain of the first ones.

Mind is your vehicle here. There's no other component of your body that will allow you to go that far, except it. In the material reality, it is represented as a brain, but in all domains it is the monad, the soul, the magic number embedded on your purpose of life that will set out your alignment with the universe.

Your mind needs feeding too, so you just can't feed it with trash TV, stupid ads and other time wasters. You have to fill it with knowledge, with gnosis. If you give it ontological math, you have a first step towards divinity yourself.

Employing dialectic to refine old teachings is the way to go, and keeping up to date with all religious and scientific advancements in order to refine the discourse of life, thus paving the path towards an enlightened society that can be responsible for itself.

There's one more domain that may be confused with the material one, but it's actually a deeper, darker, perilous one, the...

Digital domain

Each transaction we have with a computer leaves a trace of our human beings into hundreds, maybe thousands of computers. Facebook entries, Instagram shares, FourSquare logs, card transactions, surveillance cameras. All of our existence is falling into a set of computer bytes and are, literally, creating a digital *doppelganger*, a virtual double of yourself.

The age of information is over and is lending way to a new age of interpretation. We, as a society, have thousands of Petabytes with data about everyone, now humanity is using it to parse it, understand it and give it use, thus converting data into information.

Imagine a software that could create a clone of each one of us by using all of our information on all the computers where we have a record set... isn't that scary? Think X-Box live, Second Life, and any other place that requires an avatar. Do you want to belong down there, watching shadows, or get out into real life and be yourself? No monthly payment or points required, just be yourself...

Let's imagine the whole domains system as a pyramid made up by layers, with this new digital domain at the bottom end:

ABRAXAS
multidimensional
spiritual
energy
material

digital

Anyway, going back to the topic, the mind is the only conduit that you can use to navigate through all of these domains. Many people use meditation to reach these 'higher' states, or some even use LSD, DMT or similar substances in order to activate some particular areas of your brain that may be currently locked to some experiences.

Your mind holds your soul, it's the eternal monad. It may currently give form to yourself right now, but ever wondered what happens within your dreams? What about those days you feel in "3rd. Person mode"? It's like you do whatever you have to, but are not in total control of yourself. Where is your mind at those times?

How about those experiences in which you were able to use your intuition to the max and just got off the bus one station before and later realized they had been robbed? Those experiences exist, whether we want to rationalize them or not, it doesn't matter science can prove them, spiritual persons thrive on them.

So, how do you manage to experience these other states? It's just a matter of vibration. To simplify things a lot, vibration is both frequency and intensity. Let's think of a wave going up and down. Frequency is the horizontal space between each of the prominent peaks or valleys (the top or the bottom elements of the drawn vibration) and intensity or amplitude is the vertical space between a peak and a valley.

The faster the frequency is, the less horizontal space there is, thus leading to a high pitched sound. The lower it is, the deeper sound it offers. Now, the intensity lets your vibration take much or less space. Think of a set of audio speakers, the more you turn the volume up, the more the speaker cones move.

The same happens with your soul, with your mind. You can vibrate higher or lower. Ever noticed how sad people tend to go shopping or eat ice cream? They are falling prey to lower vibrations. How about those people who feel at the top of the world and receive even greater news? They look like they are about to become gods, and instantly make people happy around them.

Everything moves, and we are made of many 'everything's'. We need to raise our vibration by conscious of ourselves, of where we are, of where we want to get and how we are getting there. You were just given a chance to raise your vibration through gnosis and reach higher levels of yourself. Keep studying, and you will surely become light yourself.

Just to conclude. Many people tend to feel their lives are going in circles... it will be that way until you decide to 'elevate' yourself, studying gnosis amplifies the circumference of the circle itself, and putting it to practice makes it's next turn go one step higher, thus creating a 3D ascending spiral instead of a simple circle going back and forth nonsensically.

CREATING A WORLD

Science has taught us that the universe was created with a huge explosion cast out of nowhere, and this energy was so strong that it created mass and matter, enough to build the planets, stars, galaxies, nebulae once the particles stopped accelerating and cooling off.

As incredible as it may sound, this is very compatible with the origins of the universe according to many religions, in which a god, or a group of gods decided to create the universe, the earth, and place a whole bunch of people there; most religions say that these persons were put there to praise these gods.

We dare to find one problem with both these theories: how could you create something out of nothing?

Any explosion would require fuel, any god needs matter. No one can just materialize particles out of a vacuum. No one, even Jehova, has enough power to create something with nothing. It would require the power of, actually, a whole universe to create another whole universe the same size.

Kinetic electricity generation is the common ground place for “creating” energy in order to deliver it to your home so you can watch the news or charge your smart phone. This turns movement into electricity as such, it doesn't create electrons out of nothing.

Electricity is the result of a mechanical effort of sorts that transforms the movement from the sea, or the air in order to “create” it; you aren't getting something out of nothing. You need some sort of energy and you just transform it into something else, like solar panels, for instance.

Nothing can be created without something. Everything needs a fuel of sorts, so... how was the universe created? Well, the universe was not created at all, it's an evolving being that would represent a god as a whole, a synthesis of everything inside it.

Names are useless at this point, just think of a Cosmic god that represents the universe as a whole, the stars, the planets, the life forms, the thoughts, the ideas, good and evil, female and male, light and darkness, sins and piety; it represents everything in the universe as such.

Obviously this Cosmic god is not a creator as such, but a result of evolution. Think of it as a living being, fighting his own battle for survival, for evolution. We are nothing but smaller components of this being, as much as cells and microbes are nothing but smaller components of us.

We can visualize this by comparing atoms to planets, nebulae with terrestrial clouds or blood cells to an asteroid belt. The same patterns emerge everywhere around the universe at every level of reality, they all obey to the same mathematical fractal equation. As above, so below. As below, so above.

We are all part of the same universe, we are in fact a reflection of our own universe and the universe is in fact a reflection of us.

Coming back to the original issue, if the universe couldn't be created from nothing, what has it evolved from? The big crunch theory sounds more credible, as it grows from a small, minimum-sized ball of energy into a big universe, then shrinks back to the original size only to repeat the cycle again.

This fits perfectly with Peter Lynds theories on cosmology, in which he explains that time is actually not frames of static positions, but rather micro-movements that could hardly be measured by any optic equipment. There are two times in which one can appreciate time as such, as an instant, and that would be when time itself changes direction.

If we added a sphere shaped universe, we have the perfect setup for creating a world. Until now, no one can claim that the universe is finite; with all our technology, we have been unable to reach the end of the universe as such.

A spheric universe could explain why there is no beginning and no end to it. Could you state a beginning point for any given crystal ball? Unless you have some sort of reference, like a dent or a spot, it would be practically impossible to find these points.

Imagine yourself walking on an imaginary planetoid with a completely flat surface and no visual reference. The atmosphere is so thick that you cant visually distinguish any stars or planets, and this one doesn't have any moons or suns.

You could walk on this hypothetical planet for eternity and could never find a beginning or end point, it would just be imaginary, in fact. If we gradually made this planet bigger and bigger, you would just notice how the horizon goes flatter until it reached a point in which it looked completely flat.

Just as the universe grew in size, it allowed more matter to find it's way into forming cosmic phenomena, such as planets and stars. The universe is infinite, or at least that would be the illusion of a spheric universe, but it is still too huge to be explored by only a generation, and there's no communication technology to mark progress, so scientists would have to wait a long time in order to get results back.

But not everything in the world is visual or sensory, as we are only talking about the material domain, but, what about the mental domain? There's also energy in the realm of the mind, but, what is it made of?

In Greece philosophers such as Tales, Anaximenes and Heraclitus, proposed water, wind and fire as the primordial substance for existence. While they were getting close, they were missing something, this “substance” can't be just found just anywhere in the material domain. It's more mysterious than that, like aether, but simpler than just chemistry, it's plain math.

Lets introduce the monad, a specific type of “cosmic” element made by a special type of energy, called the *soul*. The monad is your 'soul container' as much as the soul is your 'monad container'. It holds your true essence and your life energy. Everything live holds a monad, as such.

Monads are numbers, at the end we are ontological numbers that hold within us the spirit of our character, of our intention and many more qualities. Each monad can be placed on a mental 3D area that corresponds to the material 3D area, as well. You can find a relation between both through the use of a mathematical equation called a Fourier transform.

The Cosmos is simply the biggest multidimensional fractal ever.

Mental domain is permeated to the material domain. In fact, Descartes proposed that the eyes had a double function, both as projector and as a receptor, so you would actually only see the place where you were projecting.

This proposal constitutes the basic essence of how you appreciate the material domain. You are indeed reflecting your own self on the things that surround you, the elements you see depend almost totally on the language you feed yourself with.

Take this example, if you are a positive person, full of love, you will usually find love and happiness around you, just as much as a grumpy person is usually surrounded with obstacles and demeanors. You see what you are.

So, one does not simply create something with nothing. We have numbers all around us. Numbers are not just abstract representations of reality, but rather reality is a subjective representation of numbers, as such.

The reason why math explains our world so well is because the world is mathematics at its core, and mathematicians are just trying to understand the patterns lying behind the universe, and not actually defining it through them as they may sometimes believe.

The universe is numbers at its core. They are its building blocks. All there is to the universe is evolving math, the most complex equation of all solving itself by an act of supreme, true will. That is truly a real god, Abraxas, the synthesis of all, the holistic sum of all its parts, the All, the One (as a name).

Abraxas is 0, as much as $-1 + 1$ equals exactly that, zero, such in a zero energy universe, holding the good and the evil, light and darkness, construction and destruction, a perfect balance, the ultimate equilibrium, the center of it all.

MIND VS. MATTER

Most people don't usually know what to expect over a spiritual life. Some do expect a final destination, such as the Nirvana or Heaven, while others actually expect something more before dying, and many more are just there for the frills, as they don't know what to expect from it.

Spirituality is much more than just going to a church and pray, in fact, it has to do less with religion than you could ever imagine. The problem with religions is they usually hold you down from a real spiritual life by asking you to simply accept a holy book as sacred and obey.

A spiritual life is about freeing, not enslaving, so we could logically remove them from the equation to reach for divinity. The second factor to remove is prejudice. While many persons rely on science to determine if something is true or not, others simply accepts reality for what it is, and some third group actually exceeds it by creating whole mythologies used as metaphors to explain how they actually view things.

Prejudices are simply subjective truths, but it doesn't mean they are objective facts. Another premise to remember is that not because you don't know something, it doesn't mean it doesn't happen at all. There are many phenomena in the whole universe that we couldn't even imagine.

To comprehend the Cosmos, to walk a spiritual path, one must be able to amplify the reality around her or him. That means being able to simply overlook matter as the whole, to open your perceptual frequency range, and in order to do that, you need to look within your own mind for answers.

Have you ever thought of reality as simple mass and matter? Well, it is not. Reality could be described as the quantity and quality of information you are receiving from the perceived universe. Your own reality is described by anything you have fed your brain with.

If you are a horror genre fan, it's probable that you dream of ghosts and fear (or empathize with) psychotic killers. Everything in your world revolves around the horror subject. If you are into music, everything is music for you, you can't talk about anything else.

Never underestimate the power of your mind. If you feed it with the right information, it may take you to an unexpected new level of reality, as this one is subjective to the data you feed. If you only feed it trash, well, that's all you are going to get.

Knowledge is the key to a conscious existence. Think of your brain as a computer. You could have the most powerful computer in the world, but if you install a 20 years old operating system, you are not getting any more juice out from it.

Just as the brain is simply an organic computer, it evolves as long as you keep it organically well fed and using it beyond it's basic functions. The computer is constantly updating, so you need to do the same with your operating system, specially if you are a studious person.

Anything can be easily fed, but, should you? Is it worth spending countless hours of TV shows and block buster movies instead of pursuing a spiritual life? Don't you want to expand your reality? Ever heard the expression 'you make your own reality'? Well, it may be more real than you originally thought.

Now, if you decided to walk a spiritual life, you need to learn about the mind, the monad, the main fundamental of existence. Think of the monad as your life force, the nature of your existence, a ball of energy floating in space.

Until now, you could think of your monad standing somewhere on a 3D area, but let's take it further and place it on a 6D area, one comprised by the three 'real' dimensions (length, width and height; x, y and z) and three more 'imaginary' dimensions overlapping the first three. Now you have two 3D Cartesian planes summing up a 6D area.

Summing up two 3D areas would give a whole infinite number of possibilities, as the results exceed the sum of it's parts. You could think of the 'real' plane as the material world, and the 'imaginary' ones as your cosmic position in the mental domain.

Vibration plays a fundamental role in here. Your monad isn't simply just floating in space, as with everything in this world, it vibrates, it resonates with the whole universe playing a note in the cosmic symphony.

Remember the words of Nikolai Tesla: If you want to find the secrets of the universe, think in terms of energy, frequency and vibration. Your monad acquires a sinusoidal wave movement, and it depends on you whether to expand your frequency in order to resonate more and achieve divinity, or not.

Energy could as well fuel the brightness of your monad. If you really want to achieve divinity and cast light unto others, your energy needs to stay bright and clean. If your life force is low, your brightness will be, so.

Divinity needs a centered being, it's about achieving balance. If you center yourself it will be easier to understand the chaos and thus flow with the universe in peace. Think of your mind as a very fast and powerful car, if you step on it without any direction, you will surely crash; energy works exactly the same way.

Energy, frequency and vibration. Three factors that could as well describe how a monad works, pure spiritual knowledge explained using science. Why? How come? Ain't spirituality supposed to contradict science? We asked you not to have any prejudices. Both material and mental universe hold mathematics at their cores, so it's easy to speak the same language, as they both come from the same source: numbers.

Numbers hold a rather important function in the universe, as every number has an intention. We're not talking simply about numerology in here, it's universal math made philosophy. Even the mathematician and philosopher Leibniz used his book *Monadology* to refine what Pythagorians have proposed since the days of Croton island.

Leibniz even explained how activity leads to a perfect monad while passivity leads to a defective one. A good reason to explain why change is actually good: every movement in the universe leads to change, any intention of changing the universe, to refine it, only leads to perfection, because behind the results lie a monad in motion, achieving perfection instead of wasting it's precious energy just taking from the universe, instead of the other way round.

Logic would then say that radicals are brighter than the most saintest of saints who just resides there, doing nothing.

But, returning to mind vs. matter... how can one simply take his mind elsewhere? You would actually not take your mind anywhere, but just open up your perception so you could see a complete reality, made of more domains. Yes, you could also take your mind elsewhere if you wanted to, but that requires complete control of your mind.

Meditation is a great way of letting your mind take you elsewhere. Even while traditional religions shun this kind of practices, these are fundamental keys to opening up a new eye in your brain, as they allow you to take you away from your subjective reality.

Other common practices that are used to open up your mind are psychedelics. Even when most people don't approve this, DMT and LSD are great keys to 'other realities', and have proofed their consistence even when their molecular composition has been tampered with for so many years.

The best practice is simply acquiring Gnosis, knowledge, then putting it to work. It simply won't suffice to learn something if you don't do nothing with what you've learned; even simple but well guided (by the light of Gnosis) actions can aide you in your quest towards spirituality.

The point here is to use your mind to see beyond mass and matter. The Cosmos is so much more than what you can touch. Simply think of 3G or WiFi... you have them, but you can't actually see them, but it doesn't mean they doesn't exist.

Us, as a civilization, can't just totally depend on science or mythological religions that lead nowhere, we need to trust our minds taking us to the next level, but in order to arrive to a better place, you need to provide it with a map. That map is your knowledge.

MASTERS OF THE DOMAIN

Human evolution has made a big step since the first cavemen adored the sun as nothing less than a God. Even the mighty Egyptians did so with Rah. Until now, civilization has created a full fledged repertoire of gods, any available to your own convenience.

The majority of religious groups is taken by the Abrahamic religions (Cristhianism, Judaism and Islamism), there' also the choice of Buddha, Shiva, Gaia and practically anything can be a god, except yourself.

At least that's what they have been telling you all this time long, maybe in a very subtle submissive way, by going to church or some books you have dealt with. Anyhow, that's the final quest for the light of the studios ones, becoming HyperHumans, literally gods.

Have you seen the movie 'The Matrix'? If you have read the previous articles you should know by fact that this is an analogy towards reality, that being material and mental domain. Some scientists have been trying to pass this theory about a holographic spectrum, an illusion of sorts we call 'life' handled by a super computer.

Even the Popol Vuh, ancient book of the Mayans talked about the gods, being so jealous of their own creation, so perfect, so able to see as far as the gods could, that they created a smoke that would make humans dizzy and happy, and then forget about everything else. They called this smoke the 'mitote', which is a common Latinamerican word that means something like 'party'.

If these gods were so good at creating things, why would they be jealous of their own creation? Why would they impair these beautiful invention? In the case of Mayan gods, they were jealous because humans, being so perfect, bowed to nobody, and according the tradition, the gods made the man out of corn so he would adore the gods: pure vanity, pure ego. This is the same spirit after the Demiurge, an Archon, a supreme being created by the true God himself: Abraxas.

But wait a minute! Let's stop for a second here and forget about everything you know about mythology, deities, reality, religion, spirituality or even God himself, and let's listen to a maybe new story.

Let us introduce you to a story that starts with Abraxas, a TRUE god that doesn't need anything at all from you, but to be free. It is both she and he, beyond good or evil, darkness and light. This particular god is the sum of all the parts of the Cosmos.

While many people regard Yahweh as the whole, there is more to that. Let's just think of the opposite: Satan. Without Satan, Yahweh is only half of the equation, and it still needs the other part. If you could join this (and more) together, you would get Abraxas.

Abraxas is the ultimate synthesis of the universe, the whole Cosmos itself, polarized with both charges. The inclusion of Thesis and Antithesis in this deity renders it as the true center and balance of life, itself. The concepts of 'good' and 'bad' or 'evil' were introduced by the human race to control other humans' behavior, so Abraxas is the solution to get rid of these and thus achieve a step forward to true, mental freedom.

The universe is in constant evolution, sometimes allowing more light, and sometimes more darkness according to a set of rules that build the Cosmos' behavior. As all within it, these rules are subject to change as a reaction of the Cosmos' own dialectics, even so, some laws cant be changed.

Here's an excellent law that always works: As above, so below. As below, so above. This means that energy, life force, exerts the same intention in any of the domains, whether material or not, at any level, at any layer.

Think of a person with cancer... there's destruction at every level, from the mind, the spirit of the person who may decay morally from his disease, to each and every cell with cancer. A simple destroyed cell wouldn't mean much, but they begin to destroy others, so a complete organ decays, and then the body and the person itself.

Take a look at microscope videos and then outer space ones... you will find the patterns really similar. This phenomenon happens all around the universe at every level because everything holds a vibration, basically a sine wave, a sinusoid.

Everything you can find in the universe has transformed, evolved to their current state thanks to the process of cosmic dialectics. There's no god that created a whole universe out of nothing, but indeed the universe took form thanks to a monad, The Monad.

According to Pythagoras' Mystery School, the Monad is the simplest and most minuscule element of existence, it simply cannot be divided into anything smaller. This Monad fell prey to the forces of vibration, charging it with so much energy that it simply had to create other monad out of it.

Yes, it exists, but only if includes the reality of everything, such as Abraxas does. Abraxas is the ultimate synthesis of Cosmos as such. Good and wrong, light and darkness, female and male, Eros and Thanatos.

You can live a conscious integration to Abraxas through the use of tools that amplify your mental strength, such as meditation, and of course, knowledge. This could be regarded to as what many people call 'enlightenment'. The state in which your mind is literally connected to the rest of the existence.

Ever felt the need to know something, and... voilà! You simply know it and then later find out it happened to be true? Have you ever missed the bus on purpose because it didn't 'feel right' and then realized later that it was robbed? This is intuition to the max, and it's one of the tools that connects you to the 'whole', to the 'One'.

Humans have evolved to a point where we can think of HyperHumanism as a feasible possibility, and the first HyperHuman kids are walking among us. Kids that could beat the world's best guitar player in just a couple of years, who were born to be leaders, kids that were consciously grown out of the conventional ways of life, the one that usually kills creativity and self esteem.

Apotheosis, the ability to become a god, to render your powers of creation and give reality to a new life and sense of purpose. Do you think that becoming a god is impossible? Just remember about the 'mitote' we talked about earlier. Even the Mayans who were not in (confirmed) contact with Greece held the same sort of beliefs. Obviously the Greeks were much more advanced in their studies.

So, the universe is made of monads, and the whole universe is called Abraxas (if you sum the value of the Greek letters that form the name, you get 365). So what role does Yahweh play in here?

Yahweh is what Plato called the Demiurge, the creature who made the human believe HE was the creator and top notch god of all. Yahweh is in fact a creator, and actually did a fine job in giving us a material realm in which we can all forget about our multidimensionalism.

Yahweh is the greatest prison of all, because most people regard him as 'the craftsman' who created ALL the universe. That couldn't be more far from the truth. We owe him the material realm, that way, he can trap our awareness into just four dimensions, X, Y, Z and time.


- 1.-Jealousy of not having a soul of his own?
